

See The Bible... ... COME ALIVE

DAY 1. NEW YORK. Depart the JFK AIRPORT for flight to Tel Aviv.
Dinner and first run movies in flight.

DAY 2. ISRAEL. We arrive the TEL AVIV AIRPORT where we are met and taken by private, deluxe motor coach to our first class hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3. TIBERIAS / GALILEE. Breakfast at the hotel. A very early boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Time is given for special worship service while sailing on the Sea to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' Ministry. We stand on the Mount of Beatitudes, almost hearing "Blessed are the peacemakers" from the Sermon on the Mount; visit the site of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish. Afternoon a special Baptismal Service in the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

DAY 4. TIBERIAS / JERUSALEM. Breakfast at the hotel. A visit of Gideon Springs. Our sightseeing continues to Megiddo (the Biblical site of the Battle of Armageddon mentioned in our Bible. We see Mt. Tabor in the distance, the site of the Transfiguration. We visit Mt. Carmel "Muhraqa" where Elijah fought the priests of Baal. We continue to Caesarea, an ancient Roman city with aqueduct built by Herod the Great in 22 B.C. Cornelius was baptized by Peter and Paul was brought to trial at Caesarea. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 5. JERUSALEM. Breakfast at hotel. This morning we drive to the top of the Mt. of Olives, with a visit to the Garden of Gethseme, where Jesus awaited his betrayal. We visit Patre Nostre; Dominuse Flevit, the Upper Room, and St. Peter Engalicanto. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 6. JERICHO, DEAD SEA, QUMRAN, EIN GEDI. Breakfast at the hotel. Drive down to Jericho for the ruins and excavations of the Old Jericho mentioned in the Bible. Then, we are off to the Dead Sea and Qumran, visiting Ein Gedi. This is the area where David and Saul compromised their differences. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7. JERUSALEM. Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we visit the Church of St. Anne. Following the Way of the Cross, we visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and Calvary. Afternoon, we visit the Jewish Quarter, Temple Institute, the Wailing Wall and the tunnel underneath. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 8. JERUSALEM. Breakfast at the hotel. Special Communion Services at the Garden Tomb. Then we continue to the Shrine of the Book housing the Dead Sea Scrolls; the Model of Jerusalem as it was during Jesus' time. Yad Vashem and the Valley of Elah where David fought Goliath. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 9. JERUSALEM/ TEL AVIV AIRPORT.
Breakfast at the hotel. Morning transfer by private coach to the Tel Aviv Airport for flight home.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

AIR: Departing New York, to Tel Aviv and Returning Tel Aviv to New York. Seasonal Super Apex airline tickets. Prices are based on fares as of October 15, 2019 and subject to change without prior notice. Flights are subject to airline schedules and may change without prior notice. Layovers may apply when direct flights are not available.

GROUND: Deluxe air-conditioned motor coaches.

HOTELS: First class hotels throughout. Limited number of single rooms are available at regular supplement. Rooms will be requested but are not to be considered confirmed until actual confirmations are received.

MEALS: 2 MEALS PER DAY: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily.
